NYC DOT will improve conditions along Columbus Avenue from West 110th Street to West 96th Street and West 77th Street to West 65th Street by:

- Installing a parking-protected bicycle path on the east side of the street to enhance safety and mobility; the existing curbside parking lane will be relocated with a floating (offset) parking lane from West 110th Street to West 96th Street and from West 77th Street to West 68th Street.
- Enhanced shared bicycle/vehicle lane will be added from West 68th Street to West 65th Street.
- Building concrete pedestrian refuge islands to shorten crossing distance and improve safety at approximately 23 intersections

Implementation begins July 15th
